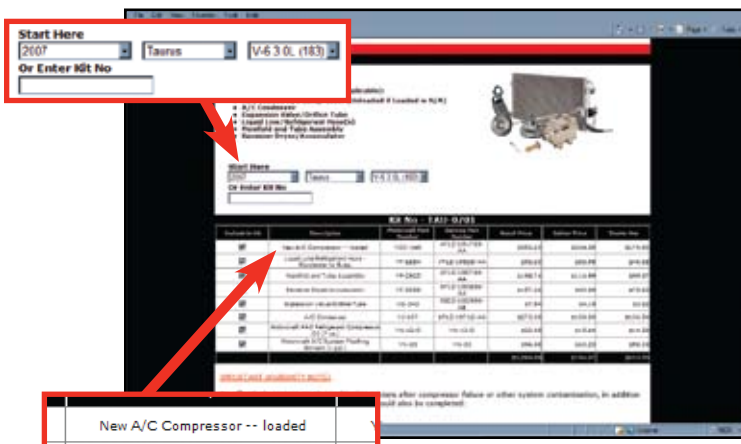
## THE TOOL AT-A-GLANCE

## LET'S GET STARTED



We've provided application data for R-134a systems starting with the 1995 model year. You will not find any R-12 application information here

- There are two ways to get your kit

Should you know the exact kit number, type it into the "Enter Kit No" box (example: FSER-0401, you must include hyphen) and the contents will be displayed

OR

Under the "Start Here" drop down menu, select the model year

- Then, select the model vehicle you're working with
- Next, select the engine...then you'll get a list of the major A/C components for that application
- Note that a "Loaded" compressor is included – "Unloaded" compressors are substituted when loaded compressors are not offered for that application
- Some kits may not include all parts, as they may not be branded as Motorcraft® parts or they may have become obsolete

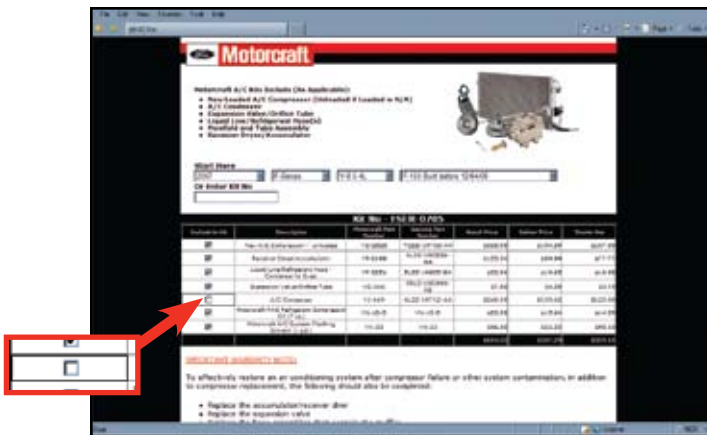
## DETAILS AND VEHICLE SPECIFIC NOTES BOX



Some vehicles have specialized parts or had mid-year component changes, so when this box pops up, be sure to check what's there...it can include:

- Build dates
- Specialized vehicle information
- With or w/o auxiliary rear A/C
- Or other details

## WHAT IF YOU DON'T NEED A WHOLE KIT?



Sometimes you may not require all parts included in our Motorcraft® A/C Kit. If this is the case, we have provided the provision to allow you to “uncheck” the box in the left hand column. All pricing will be reduced by the price of the part should you uncheck a box.

We believe you will find this a useful tool in creating quick A/C system quotes to your retail customers, installers and jobber customers as well. Pricing and application information is updated monthly.

NOTE: The MAC Kit Website is a catalog website that is designed to supplement other catalog tools (Ford Catalog Advantage, Motorcraft.com or third party catalog systems).
